Biography

Sundri grew up in France between a mixed-race family from all over the world, an English bilingual school, and especially her father's discotheque, where she cultivated her natural gift for singing and dancing since childhood. She secretly dreamed of being a singer. Her meeting in 2001 with the Creole singer Jim Fortuné opened the Reunion island scene as a backing vocalist and dancer. It was also the beginning of her passionate work around voice, writing and composition. The debut album "Accords" (2014) was nominated in the United States by the International Acoustic Music Awards and Voices of the Indian Ocean, giving Sundri Feeling a regular presence on the jazz scene and in the Reunion media. For the album "Dancing souls" (2018) she collaborated with international bassist Sylvin Marc (Nina Simone, Chris Rea).

The new album "Sundri" (2022) is a libertarian manifesto in honor of pioneer divas or anonymous women, directed by the incredible bassist Mishko M'Ba (Ray Charles, Paco Sery, Dee Dee Bridgewater, Zazie). Sundri Feeling remains animated by the quiet force of this Universal Feminine Energy that colors Sundri's voice, to make our souls travel. In French, English and Creole, the quartet touches the heart of an audience open to this musical show, a subtle blend of world music, positive poetry, dance, sensuality and more.

On stage, the recognizable bass of Mishko M'Ba joins the piano flights of Jérôme Vaccari (director of the Jazz Club Réunion), and the eclectic Frank Paco (Queen, Bono, Angélique Kidjo, Johnny Clegg) on drums.

On the International side, *Seoul Music Week 2017* was the opportunity for a 1st Asian tour, followed by a 2nd in 2018. In 2019, Sundri Feeling is invited at the *Imbizo Festival* in South Africa, *Mundos* in Las Palmas in the Canary Islands and *Mozambique Music Meeting*. Exciting new export projects are being organized further to the 2022 showcase for *MAPAS* in Gran Canaria and 2023 writing residency in La Palma.

New Album 'Sundri'

A self-produced artist, an outstanding composer, a voice that takes the soul to its most secret entrenchments... Sundri Feeling embodies the conscious possession of a destiny unsealed by the painful legacies of the generations of women who preceded her. With her new album called Sundri, she proposes to pay tribute to the illustrious pioneers who inspired the momentum of her personal and artistic trajectory, starting from her island, her mother earth. Anne Mousse, the first woman born in Reunion, Josephine Baker but also the freed slave Tiana... divas or anonymous, these women all represent the fortitude with which the artist has been able to identify and which she seeks to transmit with her songs, true libertarian manifestos in favor of hope and healing love.

Vibrating in tune with the universe, honoring the beauty of femininity as she embraces it, are the resources of "this mixed-raced, ambassador, conservative of the protective aura". Her energy source never dries up. On the other hand, it is constantly, like a bubbling stream making its way through the obstacles of life. Like a prodigal alchemist, it is in the sensitive crucible of her texts that she gracefully transforms the gravity of silence. Her uncertain genealogical ramifications then become desired trees and as a creative demiurge, she builds her own myth, narrates other possible on the rowdy riffs of Mishko M'Ba's bass, director of the album *Sundri*.

Pop-jazzy notes and suave her voice illuminate the shadow part and rock an emancipation where anchoring becomes movement and emptiness fullness.
